HIEROMARTYR IGNATION THE GOD-BEARER, BISHOP OF ANTIOCH was a disciple of the holy Apostle and Evangelist John the Theologian and the second bishop of Antioch. He has left us seven archpastoral epistles in which he provided instructions on faith, love and good works. Tradition suggests that when Saint Ignatius was a little boy, the Savior hugged him and said: "Unless you turn and become as little children, you shall not enter into the Kingdom of Heaven" (Mt. 18:3). The saint was called "God-Bearer" (Theophoros), because he bore God in his heart and prayed unceasingly to Him. He also had this name because he was held in the arms of Christ, the incarnate Son of God.
